Scout Troop 10½ – 14½ years

Meetings: Friday 7:30 – 9:15pm

A young person can come in to the Troop at 10 and may stay until he/she is 14½ years old. The Scout Troop is the third and final section in the Scout Group, and the focus is on adventure, which includes indoor and outdoor activities.

Being outdoors is important and there are many opportunities to learn the traditional Scouting skills, such as camping, survival and cooking, as well as the wide range of adventurous activities - anything from

abseiling to yachting. The Scout Troop is under the guidance of an expert team of leaders, and caters for young people of all abilities.



Scouting is about being with friends, as part of a team, participating fully in the adventure and opportunities of life.
