

NOTICE OF PUBLIC LOCAL INQUIRY WILDLIFE AND COUNTRYSIDE ACT 1981 – SECTION 53

Notice is hereby given that an Inspector will be appointed by the Secretary of State for Environment, Food and Rural Affairs to determine

Bath and North East Somerset Council
Somerset County Council, Bathavon Rural District and Keynsham Urban District
Definitive Map and Statement (Public Footpaths BA27/79 and BA27/80,
Glenavon Farm, Saltford) Definitive Map Modification Order 2019

The Inquiry will be held at Keynsham Community Space (above Keynsham Library), Market Walk, Keynsham BS31 1FS on Wednesday 13 February 2020 at 10.00am.

The effect of the Order, if confirmed without modifications, will be to modify the definitive map and statement for the area by:

- adding to them a public footpath commencing from a junction with Manor Road at grid reference ST 6708 6692 (Point A on the map attached to the Order) and proceeding in a generally northwesterly direction for approximately 200 metres to a junction with public footpath BA27/80 at grid reference ST 6697 6707 (Point B on the map attached to the Order) and continuing in a generally northwesterly direction for approximately 140 metres to a junction with public footpath BA27/30b at ST 6686 6715 (Point C on the map attached to the Order), and;
- adding to them a public footpath from a junction with public footpath BA27/27b at grid reference ST 6697 6707 (Point B on the map attached to the Order) and proceeding in a generally northerly direction for approximately 310 metres to grid reference ST 6703 6736 (Point D on the map attached to the Order) and turning in a generally easterly direction for approximately 248 metres to ST 6728 6733 (Point E on the map attached to the Order) and turning in a generally northerly direction for approximately 204 metres to a junction with public footpath BA27/27b at grid reference ST 6729 6753 (Point F on the map attached to the Order), and;
- varying the particulars relating to footpaths BA27/27b and BA27/30b.
