



First World War Centenary 11.11.18

Sunday 11 November 2018 will commence with the traditional Remembrance Sunday service at 11am at the War Memorial, followed by the service at St Mary's Church.

In the afternoon there will be a major village event at Saltford Hall organised by Saltford Parish Council, Saltford Environment Group and Saltford Community Association. It will commence at 2pm and run until 5pm and entry will be free. During the afternoon you can see/experience the following :-

- The results from the Bath Record Office WWI Saltford genealogy research on local families will be made available at the event.
- Saltford School will have a table-top display of their work marking the end of WWI
- SEG will use material concerning WWI from the Heritage Centre and its History of Saltford project to have a small display about Saltford's role and activities during WWI.
- The Avon branch of the Western Front Association will be there with a display and a medals expert so that residents can bring along any WWI memorabilia to get it identified.
- Keynsham & Saltford Local History Society will have a display of local items
- A pictorial collection of national and local pictures from the time
- Local band "Now & Then" will lead a topical music sing along

Tea and cake including "1918 War Cake" will be provided for this free entry event for Saltford's residents. We will be accepting donations for the Royal British Legion Poppy Appeal.

We encourage residents to bring along their WWI memorabilia to show to others and ask our WFA expert about them. They will also be able to search and print out recorded evidence of individuals who served or died during WW1. We also encourage residents to come forward with any local pictures they have of around 1918.
